

PE and SPORT Premium Spending 2016-2017

Introduction

Heath View Academy will receive Sports Premium Funding of £9,430 to spend in 2016/2017 to improve the quality of PE and Sport.

The priorities have been identified following a self-review to identify the Academy's strengths and areas for development in relation to PE, healthy active lifestyles and club and competitive sport.

The Academy continues to work with Steve Biltcliffe, Wakefield School Sports Network; Steve's main role is to work alongside the class teachers modelling quality PE lessons for every child as well as providing opportunities for inter-school competition.

In addition, children in both Year 5 classes go to Sun Lane for swimming lessons each week and in January 2015, Year 6 children attended an activity Residential at Robinwood. Commando Joe's are also working with our children to help them understand the importance of a healthy lifestyle and the importance of exercise.

We are also improving the quality of activities at playtime to encourage children to use equipment so that they can have fun and keep fit at the same time.

Proposed expenditure for Sport and PE

£8880.00 – School Sports-Co-ordinator – 1 day per week, providing quality CPD for class teachers and one after school club.

£1000 – after school sports clubs

£3500 - Commando Joe's

£900 - Playtime equipment

How we propose to measure the impact of expenditure

- Greater confidence in the planning and delivery of the PE curriculum. Observations of children and staff during PE lessons; teachers to use CPD training to run after school clubs.
- Equipment will be used more effectively.
- An increased number of pupils taking part in extra-curricular provision and participation in PE and Sport led by the School Sports Co-ordinator and PE subject leader.
