

PE and SPORT Premium Spending 2015-2016

Introduction

Heath View Academy will receive Sports Premium Funding of £9,350 to spend in 2015/2016 to improve the quality of PE and Sport.

The priorities have been identified following a self-review to identify the Academy's strengths and areas for development in relation to PE, healthy active lifestyles and club and competitive sport.

The Academy continues to work with Steve Biltcliffe, Wakefield School Sports Network; Steve's main role is to work alongside the class teachers modelling quality PE lessons for every child as well as providing opportunities for inter-school competition.

In addition, children in both Year 5 classes go to Sun Lane for swimming lessons each week and in January 2015, Year 6 children attended an activity Residential at Robinwood.

Proposed expenditure

£8775.00 – School Sports-Co-ordinator – 1 day per week, providing quality CPD for class teachers and one after school club.

£1000 – after school sports clubs

How we propose to measure the impact of expenditure

- Greater confidence in the planning and delivery of the PE curriculum. Observations of children and staff during PE lessons; teachers to use CPD training to run after school clubs.
- Equipment will be used more effectively.
- Increased extra-curricular provision and participation in PE and Sport led by the School Sports Co-ordinator and PE subject leader.
